 - What activities do you plan to be involved in at the college level?
 - How will your continuing education help the agriculture industry?
- 4) 2 letters of recommendation
- 5) Copy of high school or college transcript

1-2 scholarship(s) in the amount of \$400-1,000 will be awarded. The funds will be divided equally between the semesters of the institute you are attending.
